During these 40 days, we ask all laity to do the following for the purification of the Church, our bishop, and all priests in our diocese, especially those *unjustly* suffering in “limbo.”

- Attend *three* Sunday Masses with Bishop Malloy (7:30 a.m., Cathedral); then gather outside and pray the three mysteries of the Rosary taught by Our Lady to St. Dominic
- Pray the Rosary *daily* as Our Lady of Fatima asked
- Fast each week (any number of days M-Sat), abstain from meat every Friday, and give up some things that are separating you from God and/or the fulfillment of your duties in life.



Prayer to St. Athanasius the Apostolic
